Academics

Pre-Primary Department

- Children in pre-primary love to learn new things around them all the time.
- The virtual world is as natural to them as the real world outside.
- By interacting with other children virtually, they get closer to each other in a highly controlled manner.
- Those few hours that kids dedicate every day helps them develop core social skills holistically.
- By using tactile objects, such as balloons, stuffed toys and material readily available at home, teachers expressively explain alphabets, numbers in a highly engaging manner.
- Goody Packets were sent to all the new entrants as a token of love.





- Under this prolonged combat of COVID-19, BBPS Ludhiana staff members have been working tirelessly to keep their students engaged in effective teaching learning process.
- The school has provided extensive support to the students with continued e- learning by organizing online classes and providing course material through virtual platforms i.e. Google Meet and Google Classroom from Day 1.



- New academic session 2021-22 commenced on 5 April, 2021 with utmost vigour and diligence following proper schedule and time table.
- Online Interactive Sessions were organised to get familiar with the students.
- Various teaching aids such as self-made PPTs, You tube links, quizzes and activities related to the subjects are being used by the teachers to make online teaching effective as well as interesting.
- Informative and creative **practice worksheets** for all the subjects have been provided to understand the concept thoroughly .
- To keep a check on academic activities of the students, a well framed Notebooks checking schedule is shared with the students.

Online Revision Tests have been organised to assess the progress and understanding of the students. Parent Teacher Meet using Google Platform was organized for all classes. Parents appreciated sincere and dedicated effort put by the entire BBPS

• To assess academic growth of the students, **Pre Mid Term Tests** have been conducted for classes I to V from **June 1, 2021 to June 10, 2021 using Google Form**.









- 1.Session for all grades (except class XI) started on 5 April 2021. For grade XI the session started on 10 May 2021.
- 2. Entire process of migrating of students from one grade to next grade in BBPS Connect, Google Classroom and other records was done seamlessly under the guidance of IT team beforehand.
- 3. As planned at the time of implementation of BBPS Connect all grade VI students were given fresh student ids while admitting them to grade VI in Unit -2. The process of disabling the previous ids was done simultaneously in coordination with administrative department so as to avoid any apparent gap in fee and other records.

- 4. This year the online time table has 4 teaching blocks per day of 1 hr. each for grades VI to XII and 50 minutes each for grades I to V. These sessions have been planned in a manner to maintain proper balance between adequate study time and acceptable screen time.
- 5. In order to enhance Student Teacher and Parent Teacher connect in impersonal mode of online teaching two days of Orientation sessions were planned in the beginning of the Academic session. These were planned in a manner to help familiarize students and new class incharges and subject teachers and to communicate changes in the pattern of conduct of EPC and Bridge courses.
- 6. For grade XI the streaming was done based on students preference and merit list (based on performance in class X) taken together. Two major changes have been introduced this year with introduction of Core Mathematics and Sociology as main subject option for Commerce and Humanities stream respectively. Both of these have good initial response with 16 students out of 27 in Humanities opting for Sociology.

- Assessment forms an important part of education and following the same, the school conducted Assessment -1 examinations for all grades I to XII (except grade XI) from June 1 to June 12, 2021. This was objective type assessment conducted in an online mode. The attendance for the same has been about 97%.
- 8. The performance record of the students is being compiled and analyzed for identification of student and class specific learning gaps. Based on this assessment we intend to conduct remedial sessions in the first week of July.
- 9. While the assessment -1 was being conducted, regular online sessions were in progress for grade XI so the timings of the examinations and duties were planned accordingly. It is intended to conduct assessment for class XI in second week of July.
- 10. As a measure of parent connect online PTM was held on 22 May 2021. The attendance for the same was average 89% across the school. The parents who could not attend the meeting were contacted by class incharges personally. All the remarks have been duly recorded for perusal by senior management.

Baisakhi Celebration




- Bal Bharatians celebrated Baisakhi to make it vibrant and joyous to usher in good times and happiness through exhilarating activities.

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












Earth Day Celebrations

- Students of Primary wing participated in activities like Change Your Habits and Reuse to Recycle. They also made videos of plants around them.






































6 May 2021

- The main aim was to teach students to be responsible citizens.








ONLINE SUMMER INFERNSHIP FOR PSYCHOLOGY STUDENTS XI & XII


Online Psychology Internship for Psychology Students

English Proficiency Classes

- In order to help our students improve upon their English language skills, school had started 'English Proficiency Classes' in academic session 2020-21.
- This programme was very well received by our students and appreciated by parents.
- During the previous academic year this programme was conducted as supplementary to regular English subject sessions and was allotted evening timings beyond the regular time table, but due to wide appreciation and acceptance, it has now been incorporated in regular time table with two hours of dedicated lectures per class per week.

- Also the scope of the programme has been increased to cover grades I to X (from grade I to VII in the previous academic session).
- Supplementary programme of 'English Reading Classes' for Grades I, II and III has also received reviews from parents and other stakeholders.

As we all know about this pendemic period which is still going on and we do not know about for how much time period will it continue. 

- The school has started a 'Mathematics Bridge Course'
 this academic session for grades VI and VII to reinforce
 (and cover learning Gaps) basic mathematical skills
 which not only help our students academically but also
 helps them overcome the phobia of numbers and
 calculations.
- At present this covers students of Grade VI and VII so as to help hem tide over the gradation in the subject as they move from primary to middle level.

- This programme has received rousing acceptance from all stakeholders and based on the same, it is proposed to expand its scope from grade III to grade VII by August 2021.
- Online sessions for mathematics Bridge course are held after the regular school time table for 2 hours per class per week with separate sessions for evaluation of progress made by students.
- Just like EPC, the entire content for Mathematics Bridge course has been developed in house.


