


(People who gave us the 75th year of India's Independence)

- Students would write Paragraphs/Essays/Poem or create a painting according to above mentioned categories and topics.
- ❖ The write ups/paintings must me original. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ This will be appraised as your Subject Enrichment Activity so participation is mandatory for all.
- ❖ All the entries will be evaluated and shortlisted one's would be submitted to CBSE. Best entries would be awarded with e-certificates by CBSE and would get an opportunity to be selected at the regional and further national level.
