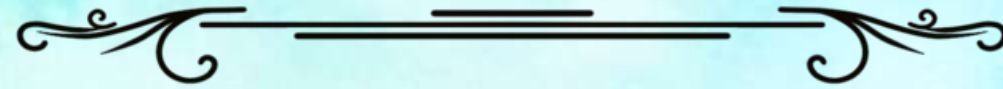


- The School Principal conducted a workshop on Happy Classrooms at Budha Dal Public School, Samana as a resource person CBSE on 11 February 2023.
