- The videos will be judged based on creativity, design, content, clarity of message, and overall impact.
- All participants must adhere to a code of conduct that prohibits plagiarism, cheating, or any other unethical practices.
- Any entry found to violate the rules, or fail to meet the criteria, may be disqualified at the discretion of the judges.

- Any entry found to violate the rules, or fail to meet the criteria, may be disqualified at the discretion of the judges.
